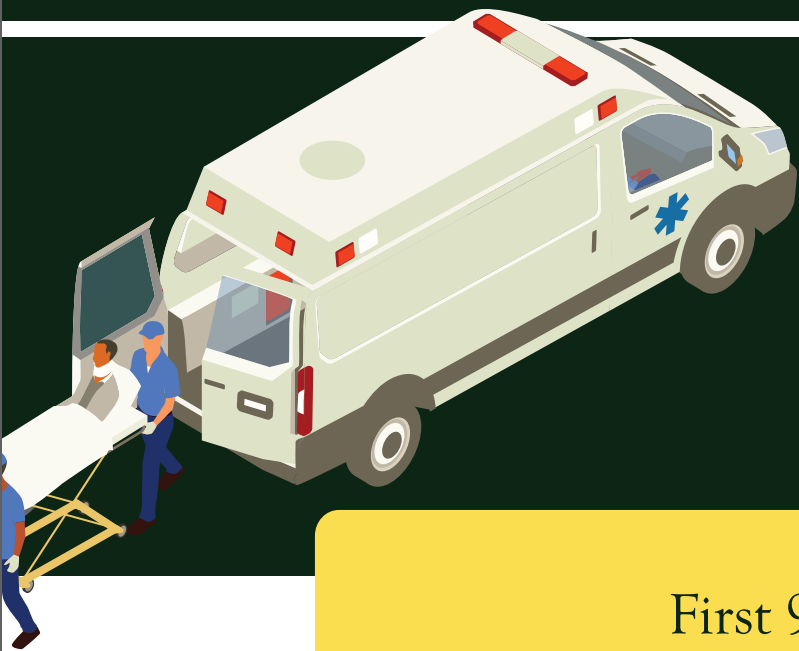


Medical Treatment for a Pennsylvania Work Injury

Know the requirements for workers' comp to pay for your work injury.



Emergency Treatment

You can go to **any provider** for emergency treatment.

First 90 days after the injury

If your employer **has provided a list** of designated providers, you must choose a provider from the list for non-emergency care.



Legal requirements for the list:



Must include at least 6 providers, at least 3 of whom must be physicians,



Must include appropriate medical specialties for anticipated work-related injuries, and



The listed providers must be geographically accessible.



If your employer **has not provided a list** that meets these legal requirements, you can see any provider of your choice.

You can go to a provider not on the list if:

A provider on the list refers you to a provider who is not on the list,



You need specialty care, and there is no appropriate specialist on the list,

OR

You are prescribed surgery and want a second opinion.



Remember, you can switch freely between listed providers!

After 90 Days

You are free to see any medical provider of your choice for your work injury.

If you see a provider **not on the employer's designated list**,

you must notify your employer **within five days of your visit** to that provider.
